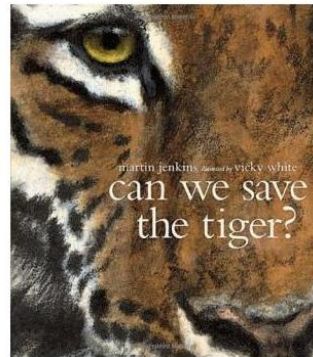
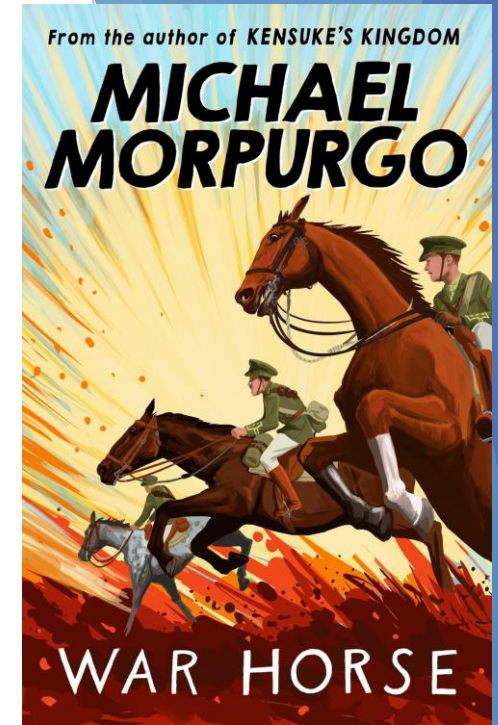
Whole Class Reading

English

- ▶ Writing focus
- ▶ Broken down into units
- ▶ Use a range of stimuli including texts and clips
- ▶ Range of genres covered - fictions and non-fiction e.g. diary entries, narratives, biographies etc.
- ▶ Cross-curricular links - Circulatory system, World War I and II.
- ▶ War Horse, Alma, The Lost Words The Three Brothers, Can we Save the Tiger?



Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS)

- ▶ Every English lesson has a grammar focus.
- ▶ By the end of Year 6, children should be using .?! and (),- and ::;
- ▶ The children will be exposed to a lot of grammatical terminology that they need to know and use.
- ▶ Grammar and punctuation is woven into English lessons.
- ▶ Spellings are taught weekly and followed up as homework

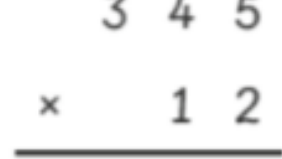

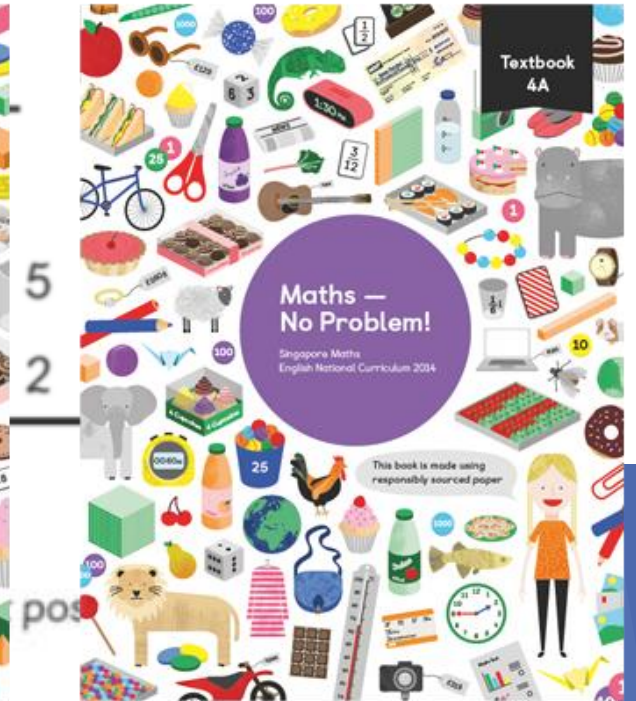
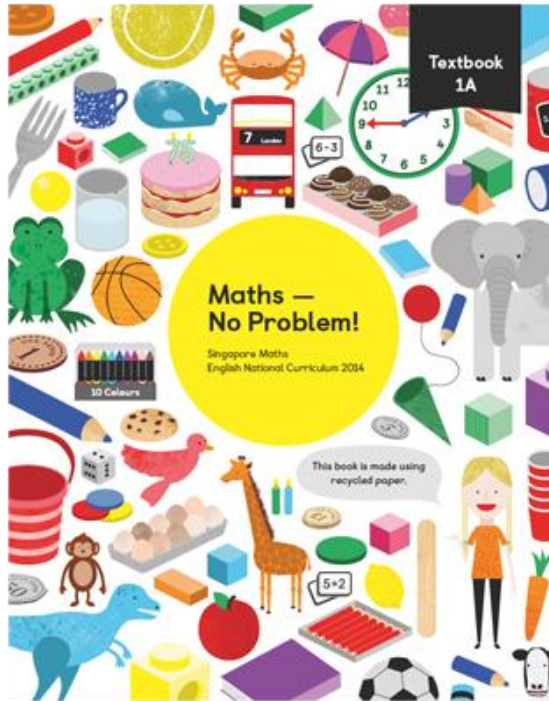

Attendance at Abbey

- Ring/email the office if your child is unwell.
- Dentist/doctors - bring your child back.
- Below 92% (Arbor) you must provide medical evidence.
- Ask for help.
- Leave of absence request. No holidays in term time will be authorised *except in exceptional circumstances*.
- New rules – August 19th 2024.

Attendance at Abbey

New rules:

- Miss 5 days = £160 fixed penalty fine per parent, per child.
- Irregular attendance (miss 10 sessions within 10 weeks) = £160 fixed penalty fine per parent, per child.
- If repeat within 3 years = £160 fine with no reduction for early payment.
- If further repeat within 3 years = prosecution, magistrate court, £2500 fine.
